Conclusion

Death was more prevalent in patients with preoperative malignancy, cardiovascular disease, trauma, [head injury](#), and [congenital anomalies](#). Attention should be paid to improve surgical and anesthetic management in these patients. Adverse events were found in one-sixth of deaths. Preventable surgical and anesthetic adverse events occurred in 8.62% of the total deaths.
